

SURVEYING INTERN

The Surveying Intern will be an active member of our surveying team, working under the supervision of a Professional Land Surveyor or Senior Survey Technician. In this role, the Surveying Intern will gain hands-on experience in various aspects of land surveying including boundary, topographic, construction, and ALTA/NSPS surveys. The intern will assist with both office and field tasks such as processing field data, drafting survey documents, and conducting basic research using plats and legal descriptions. The ideal candidate should be detail-oriented, eager to learn, and capable of following direction while also demonstrating initiative. This position offers a valuable opportunity to build foundational surveying skills and contribute to real-world projects in a collaborative environment.

Responsibilities

- Support survey crews with basic tasks during construction staking, boundary, topographic, and ALTA/NSPS surveys
- Conduct simple computations under supervision, such as basic coordinate geometry or elevations
- Assist in gathering deeds, plats, and legal documents needed for survey projects.
- Create basic CAD drawings and sketches under guidance and help input survey data into mapping software

- Familiar with surveying equipment, procedures, and software
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Attention to detail and ability to maintain accurate records
